### Parent/Caregiver/Guardian Opinion Survey

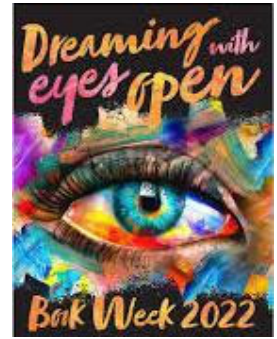
**Display in 7 – 12 Corridor**

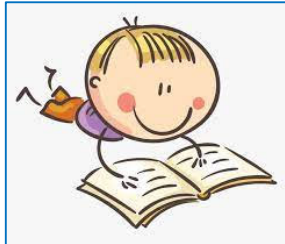
### Reading Awards
